- ➤ Caring Hearts: For August, we had 31 volunteers pack 110 boxes, totaling 33 volunteer hours and presented the program manager a \$500 check donation to offset increased food costs and plastic bags used to separate meats from fruits/vegetables. Next event will be 27 September 0815 and members are encouraged to donate plastics bags to the program. We help pack care packages at the O' Fallon Methodist Church on Highway 50. every 4th Saturday of the month. We need more volunteers to help sort the food to be put on the truck at the warehouse. The International President, Dan Yoemans, pushed the AFSA 4 pillars—Legislation, Communications, membership and fraternity. Several panels of interest were held such as the MAJCOM CC panel.
